

GLD Alternative Presentation Expectations

General guidelines:

Presentation options outside of Discover UofSC include a publication, submission for a nominated scholarship, campus, regional or national conference, or selected other alternative presentations. Presentations must be given by no more than two (2) total presenters, be open to the public, and include details about a beyond the classroom experience, as well as the student's reflection.

Logistics:

- For **publications**:
 - Students should submit a .PDF copy of the published journal article in their GLD application
 - For accepted, but still in press articles, students should submit a .PDF proof of the article in their application
 - Journals must be peer-reviewed/edited; therefore, this excludes newsletter submissions, blogs, etc.
 - On campus publication options include the *Caravel* journal and *Carolina CrossTalk* magazine. *CrossTalk* submissions must be written by the student and edited with the CrossTalk editorial board.
- For **scholarships**:
 - Must be a scholarship or fellowship approved by the Office of Fellowships and Scholar Programs (e.g. Truman, Goldwater, Gilman, NOAA Hollings, Boren, Udall, NSF, DAAD)
 - Students should submit all application materials, including personal statements/essays in their GLD application
- For **campus, regional or national conferences**:
 - Students should complete the Alternative Presentation form on our website and upload into their GLD application
 - Students should submit a copy of the conference presentation in their GLD application
- For **term-specific presentations**:
 - **CIEL Fall Showcase** is restricted to ONLY GLD students graduating in the fall semester. Only invited students will be permitted to present
 - **Summer Research Symposium** is available for GLD students graduating in the summer semester, as well as other students who register to present. This event is open to all students, not just those pursuing GLD
- The following experiences **DO NOT** fulfill GLD alternative presentation requirements:
 - Senior Honors Thesis Defenses
 - Capstone Scholars Leadership Program Presentations
 - One on One demonstration or presentations to supervisor/mentor
 - Presentations given to class and/or for class requirements
 - Submission to Scholar Commons repository through University Libraries

Timeframe:

Alternative presentation plans must be included in the student's GLD application by their assigned application deadline (based on ePortfolio completion semester). It is the student's responsibility to upload all required documentation, including the Alternative Presentation Form (if applicable), in order to submit their GLD application by the deadline.
