The University System Committee of the University of South Carolina Board of Trustees met at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 17, 2022, in the Business and Education Building Conference Center at USC Aiken and by Microsoft Teams.

## **OPEN SESSION**

## I. <u>Call to Order</u>

Chair Moody called the meeting to order, welcomed those in attendance, and asked Trustees in the room to introduce themselves. Secretary Howell confirmed those joining by Microsoft Teams.

Chair Moody called on Mr. Stensland to introduce members of the media. There were no members of the media in attendance. Chair Moody stated notice of the meeting and the agenda were posted and the press notified as required by the Freedom of Information Act; the agenda and supporting materials were circulated to the Committee; and a quorum was present to conduct business.

#### II. <u>Report from USC Upstate Chancellor</u>

Chair Moody called on USC Upstate Chancellor Bennie Harris to present the USC Upstate report.

Dr. Harris provided an overview of his time at USC Upstate. With his Cabinet, Dr. Harris has set three budget priorities for USC Upstate: 1) expand enrollment to support the region's goal to increase four-year degree attainment, 2) support the growth and economic development of the Upstate region, and 3) build a bold and competitive comprehensive university.

Dr. Harris stated that, with these priorities in mind, he began to meet with various stakeholders and entities around the state with the goal of building collaborative partnerships. Using feedback from those conversations, he identified areas of strength and opportunity for USC Upstate.

Dr. Harris then reviewed various statistics pertaining to USC Upstate.

Dr. Harris introduced the next steps taken, starting with the Reimagine Conference held on November 15, 2021. He discussed the Ongoing Institutional Program Review, during which both administrative and academic programs have been reviewed for effectiveness and relevance.

Dr. Harris announced that the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges has informed USC Upstate of their recommendation for reaccreditation with no conditions.

Chair Moody thanked Dr. Harris and stated the report was received as information.

Chair Moody called for any other matters to come before the Committee. There were none.

There being no further business to discuss, Chair Moody declared the meeting adjourned at 10:25 a.m.
